## NEW AT TIU:

- **3 New Programs:** Our new **Computer Science** major, with a balance of math and computer courses, gives you the tools you need for a successful career in technology. Our new **Criminal Justice** program is designed to prepare students for a wide variety of career choices in the areas of law enforcement, cyber-crime, paralegal, and postgraduate work. Students participating in the new **Social and Interactive Media** program will develop their skills in digital writing and in a variety of visually-based mediums, such as photography, web design, and video.
- **Dual degree options:** Trinity offers six exciting dual degree programs that allow students to earn both a Bachelor of Arts and a Master of Arts (Intercultural Studies, Bioethics, Leadership, Psychology/MA in Counseling, Exercise Science/MA in Athletic Training, Pre-Seminary/MDiv).
- **Transfer-specific financial aid options:** Trinity is now more affordable for transfer students. We offer need-based grants, academic scholarships, and a *Phi Theta Kappa* scholarship to eligible students.
- **Innovative Pre-Seminary program:** This groundbreaking early-entry MDiv program is designed for high-academic capacity students sensing an early call to pastoral ministry. This program lays a foundation for an effective ministry of biblical understanding in the context of a local church ministry. It is designed to enable a student to do further graduate studies in a seamless BA/Master of Divinity program between Trinity International University and Trinity Evangelical Divinity School (TEDS).

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Students who have enrolled in a semester of college courses post high school are considered transfer students.
- Students with less than 12 hours must submit ACT or SAT scores.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required.
- Must submit official high school transcript and all official college transcripts.

### TRANSFER OPTIONS:

- **Associates degree:** Earning an Associates degree in Art, Science, or Fine Arts fulfills general education requirements with the exception of the Foundations of Christian Thinking & Living category (3 courses).
- **IAI:** Completion of IAI (Illinois Articulation Initiative) requirements fulfills general education requirements with the exception of the Foundations of Christian Thinking & Living category (3 courses).
- An advisor at TIU will do a one-on-one evaluation that will determine course-by-course what classes will transfer.

### TRANSFER CREDITS

The maximum number of semester hours transferable is 82. Reasons credits will not transfer:

- Receiving a "C—" or below in a class.
- Continuing Education courses will not transfer.

## CALCULATION OF GPA

Grades of “C—” and below are not acceptable for transfer credit, but they will be calculated in determining the cumulative GPA.

If a student attended more than one college, we will average the GPAs together.

We do not calculate any transfer work into a student’s TIU GPA.

## FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

Completion of a foreign language is required to fulfill general education requirements. This can be achieved by:

- Receiving a “C” or higher in 2 years of foreign language classes in high school
- Taking 1 semester of a second year language course at the college level
- Taking 2 semesters of elementary language courses at the college level

## ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Transfer Academic Scholarships:** \$6,000/year given to students who achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or above; \$3,500/year given to students who achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above.
  - **Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship:** \$4,000/year given to students who are members of Phi Theta Kappa, in addition to any other scholarships they receive
  - We also offer need-based grants. TIU’s FAFSA code is **001772**
