Transfer Admission Guidelines

- Transferable GPA of at least 2.0. (4.0 scale)
- Transferable credits require a grade of "C" or better
- Less than 12 transferable semester hours will be evaluated with high school GPA and completed college courses.
- More than 12 transferable semester hours will be evaluated for admission only on college work.
- Up to 68 hours of credit from two-year institutions accepted.
- Up to 90 hours of credit from four-year institutions accepted.
