Business and Professional Writing equips students with skills and competencies needed to work as successful technical communicators in a variety of industries.

Courses explore the breadth of the profession, including general technical communication, content, management, visualization, media technology, and information design.

The **Cybersecurity** degree emphasizes development of analytic and problem solving skills to evaluate and summarize the fundamental cybersecurity concepts, theories and strategies. Students will be prepared to recommend technical and non-technical security solutions on various cyber systems, interpret and apply cyber incident response plans, and assess risks, vulnerabilities and threats to cyber systems.

The **Supply Chain Management** minor is designed to prepare students for a professional career in the most dynamic and comprehensive field in any industry, supply chain management. Students will possess the knowledge, skills, and abilities for career opportunities in the supply chain management field in positions including Operations Manager, Logistics Analyst, Supply Chain Manager, Purchasing Manager, and Logistics Manager.

The **BS/MS in Athletic Training (3+2 option)** is a unique program, designed so that students can complete both the Bachelor of Science in Exercise Science and Sports Performance and the Master of Science in Athletic Training degrees in a total of five years. Students in the accelerated BS/MSAT program who satisfactorily fulfill all requirements outlined are guaranteed admission into the MSAT portion of the program.
