## SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS

### TRANSFER MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

- 3.4 GPA or higher: \$18,000
- 2.6 GPA to 3.3 GPA: \$14,000
- Below 2.6 GPA: \$10,000

### TUITION GRANTS

More than \$39.5 million is awarded annually from university resources and endowed scholarship funds to students who demonstrate a financial need. Awards vary based on the student's level of financial need.

### PHI THETA KAPPA (PTK) SCHOLARSHIP

\$2,000 awarded to current members of PTK. Must provide proof of membership.

## TRANSFER ADMISSION

### GPA REQUIREMENTS

Transfer applicants should have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher with the exception of the programs listed below:

- » Athletic Training Program 2.5 GPA
- » Education Programs 2.7 GPA
- » Nursing Program 3.0 GPA

### CREDIT TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

- Courses must be taken at an accredited national or regional two or four-year college or university.
- Courses in the major may require departmental approval unless, through common practice or articulation agreements, the course has been previously accepted.

*The best way to determine what credits will transfer is to have your transcripts sent to Millikin's Office of Admission.*

### GRADES

- » Grades of "C-" or higher are accepted.
- » Credit for the course transfers, not the grade.
- » Honors are calculated only for grades and credits earned at Millikin University.
