Transfer Admission Requirements

- Apply online through our Monmouth College Application
- Official transcripts must be submitted from each college or university attended
 - Unofficial transcripts are not accepted for admission
- Students in their first college semester, or with fewer than 12 completed credit hours, must also submit official high school transcripts
- A personal statement may be requested
- ACT/SAT scores are not required

Transfer Credit

- Maximum of 80 credit hours accepted
 - Maximum of 64 credit hours can be accepted from 2-year institutions
- Courses with a D or better transfer
 - A C- or better is required for a course to apply toward a major or minor
 - A C or better is required for a course to apply toward teacher licensure
- Students who complete an Associate of Arts, Science, or Fine Arts will transfer at junior standing
- Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI) receiving only institution

Scholarships & Financial Aid

- Dean's Scholarships for transfer students range up to \$29,000 per year
- Wallace Founders Transfer Scholarship Competition:
 - On campus interviews between March 16-20, 2026, minimum 3.0 GPA
 - Awards up to \$5,000, renewable up to 3 years
- Phi Theta Kappa Scholarships range up to \$2,000
 - Phi Theta Kappa membership must be indicated at the time of applying to Monmouth on the official transcript or by submitting a membership certificate
- Talent based scholarships requiring an audition or portfolio:
 - Art, Music, Theatre, & Bagpipes & Highland Drumming
- Additional academic and special interest scholarships requiring interviews:
 - Classics, Presbyterian, & the Richard "Doc" Kieft Chemistry Scholarship
- FAFSA Filer Grant of \$500 each year a FAFSA is filed and sent to Monmouth
