- Based upon outstanding academic performance and demonstrated leadership
- Up to FULL TUITION

MILLIKIN MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

- Based upon potential to contribute to campus community; awarded to all admitted students
- Up to \$20,000/year

PHI THETA KAPPA (PTK) SCHOLARSHIP

- Based upon membership to PTK
- Up to \$2,000/year

Transfer Admission Requirements

GPA

- » All applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
- » Nursing applicants- 3.0+ GPA
- » School of Education applicants- 2.7+ GPA
- » Athletic Training applicants- 2.5+ GPA

CREDITS

- » Courses must be taken at a nationally or regionally accredited two- or four-year college or university.
- » Some courses may require department approval.
- » Courses completed with a grade of C- or higher are accepted.

The best way to determine what credits will transfer is to have your transcripts sent to Millikin's Office of Admission by your previous institution(s).



Transferring from a Community College

Millikin has a variety of existing partnerships with community colleges in central Illinois. We understand the benefits of these partnerships for students and are open to discussions on the creation of new partnerships going forward.

Honors Program

REQUIREMENTS

- >> 3.5 cumulative GPA at previous institution.
- » Evidence of academic excellence, for example:
 - -Membership in previous institution's honors program
 - -Membership in nationally recognized honors societies, such as Phi Theta Kappa
