Elmhurst University Updates

- Elmhurst University is one of the first PTK Connect Direct Transfer Admission Partners in the country. PTK members can apply online via the PTK Portal.
- Our brand new state of the art Health Science Building officially opened for the 25-26 school year hosting the Diane Tyrrell Department of Nursing and Public Health, Occupational Therapy, and Communication Sciences and Disorders Programs. The building also hosts our Speech-Language-Hearing Clinic, Simulation Nursing Labs, and the Jans Center for Veterans.
- We've been named to the PTK Transfer Honor Roll for the **sixth** year in a row!
- We now accept Transfer Student Applications through the Common App.
- Elmhurst has introduced new majors in Biomedicine, Neuroscience, Bioinformatics, Engineering Physics, Entrepreneurship, and Elementary Special Education.

Admission Requirements

- A cumulative GPA of 2.5 and 30 semester hours completed at the college level (under 30 hours requires a review of high school transcripts).
- **Education:** Requires a separate application and a minimum 2.75 overall GPA
 - Please consult the education webpage for more information: www.elmhurst.edu/education
- **Nursing:** Requires a separate application, 12 prerequisites and a minimum 3.2 overall GPA and 2.8 science GPA
 - Fall 2026 application deadline is January 26, 2026- waitlist in place for after the deadline
 - Please consult your admission counselor or the nursing website for requirements: www.elmhurst.edu/nursing
- **Business:** Requires a 2.75 overall GPA and a grade of C or better in College Algebra and English Composition II
- **Communication Sciences & Disorders:** Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA to begin 200-level courses and a 3.2 overall GPA to continue in the program.

Transfer Scholarship Opportunities

- **Merit Based Academic Scholarships** - range in value from \$10,000-\$22,000
- **Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) Merit Scholarships** - range in value from \$19,000-\$24,000 (in place of merit scholarship mentioned above) - require a minimum 3.25 cumulative GPA and PTK membership at the time of application
- **Music Scholarship** - range from \$11,000-\$22,000 - values align with merit scholarship and are not in addition to. Requires an audition to be awarded; for more information, please contact **Gayle Bisesi**, music.admission@elmhurst.edu
- **Associate Degree Award** - \$1,000 - requires completion on an associate degree prior to transfer
- **First Generation Grant** - valued at \$2,000 - for first generation students
- **United Church of Christ Scholarship** - \$2,000 - for active members of the UCC
- **Legacy Scholarship** - \$2,000 - for students with immediate family members who are alumni or currently attending Elmhurst
- **Art & Theatre Talent Scholarship** - range in value up to \$2,000, please contact department for more information:
