



OUR APPLICATION:

Students can apply online through our [SXU Application](#) which has no fees. Our application is open and we are currently accepting applications for Spring 2027. We recommend applying as early as possible. We review applications on a rolling basis for non-nursing programs. As soon as all application materials are received, a typical admission decision will be made within two weeks of submission.

TRADITIONAL BSN APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

For all SXU application types, a completed application includes a submitted application and official college transcript(s) from any and all colleges/universities attended. Students with fewer than 30 credit hours are also required to submit their official final high school transcript. Applicants to our nursing program (Transfer BSN) are required to submit additional materials that may include:

- An official TEAS exam score (58.7%)
- A nursing essay of interest

COST OF ATTENDANCE (2026-2027):

Tuition & Fees: \$40,260 (non-nursing); \$42,390 (nursing)

Room/Board: \$13,500 (based on suite-style upperclassmen room with mid/high-range meal plan)

Total Estimated Cost of Attendance: \$53,760

Please note: The cost of attendance components listed are based on undergraduate, full-time enrollment (12-18 credit hours per semester). The data is estimated based on averages; actual costs may vary.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

When students complete an SXU application, they are automatically reviewed for SXU's merit-based scholarships!

- Transfer Merit Scholarship:
 - \$10,000-\$21,000/year based on academic credentials
- Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) Scholarship:
 - \$22,000/year. Supersedes the Transfer Merit Scholarship
- Community colleges may provide additional scholarship opportunities (Chicago Star Scholarship, Crawley Scholarship, etc.)
- Access Advantage Tuition Program: SXU is committed to providing a quality education at an affordable cost and we strive to ensure that cost is not a barrier to a transformational college education. Through the Access Advantage program, qualifying incoming full-time freshmen and transfer students will have their base [tuition costs covered](#) for their first year of attendance through a combination of state, federal and institutional aid sources!
