Here's a look at our newly implemented majors/minors:

Child Life Specialist

Child Life Specialists work primarily within the healthcare field, assisting children and their families in coping with anxieties associated with hospitalization and treatment. They ensure a child's social, emotional and cognitive growth during periods of hospitalization, and facilitate communication between the child and hospital staff.

Agricultural Science

This is a 2+2 Ag Science capstone program. Students having completed an A.A.S. degree from approved Ag programs are eligible and credits are accepted as a block of transfer credits. Students gain the benefit of a liberal-arts education with employment advantages of a 4-year degree. Students learn research, analysis, chemistry basics for soil and nutrient analysis, environmental policies and regulations related to agriculture and the relationship of organisms to environment.

Neuroscience Minor

A Neuroscience minor gives interdisciplinary training in psychology, biology and chemistry for students seeking advanced degrees in brain science. Students gain requisite knowledge to pursue careers in neurology, cognitive neuroscience, behavioral neuroscience and neurosurgery. The curriculum supports biology, chemistry, psychology and pre-med programs.

Elementary/Special Education Double Major

This double major allows students a timely double major completion, preparing them for a license in Special Ed and Elementary Ed. Students take part in our Education seminar allowing them to learn about critical topics, gain interview skills and garner peer mentoring and support. Our Program Directors maintain connections with educators to create quality field placements.
