- **Direct to Success (D2S)** We offer our Direct to Success Scholarship, a 25% tuition rate value, for students who have a minimum 2.0 GPA, complete an associate degree from one of our partner colleges and transfer within a year of graduation. For more information please visit www.transfer.nl.edu
- **Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI)** The Centro de Excelencia at NLU serves as the hub for programs and initiatives that advance our work as a community and career focused HSI. Currently, 47% of our undergraduate students identify as Latinx.
- NLU's Accelerated Pathway to Teaching For students who have college credits in other subject areas other than education and want to become an elementary school teacher, NLU now offers students the opportunity to take graduate level teacher preparation coursework as an undergraduate in the BA Applied Behavioral Sciences (ABS) program. ABS students can earn a Master's degree (M.A.T.) and an Illinois professional educator license (PEL).
- Social Work Major NLU introduced BA Social Work in Fall 2021.
- **Upcoming new majors** (Spring 2022) NLU will introduce a new BA Secondary Education in 2022.

EDUCATION PROGRAMS

- NLU now offers five undergraduate education programs: B.A. in Early Childhood Education, B.A. in Infant-Toddler Studies, B.A. in Elementary Education, B.A. in Applied Educational Studies, and B.A. in in Early Childhood and Elementary Education. Programs are available 100% online, on campus, in the evening or weekend.
- New Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood and Elementary Education program Completion of this program allows students to earn both the Early Childhood Education (birth - grade 2) and Elementary Education (grades 1-6) endorsements.

An emphasis on mission-driven leadership, datadriven and research-informed practice and decision-making, and student-centered outcomes define the program.

Postsecondary Teaching and Instructional Leadership This program serves postsecondary educators who seek to deepen their professional teaching practice, expand knowledge of instructional approaches that help college students learn, adopt a critically reflective approach to teaching, and strengthen capacities to approach college students as adult learners.
