

ILLINOIS COLLEGE TRANSFER HIGHLIGHTS

Transfer Admission & Application Requirements

- :: Illinois College's foundations and explorations general education requirements will be waived for students with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree
- Students must earn at least 32 semester hours of academic credit at Illinois College, with 24 of the last 32 completed in residence

Transferring Credits

- :: Transferable courses must be taken at an accredited college or university
- :: The courses must be undergraduate academic offerings at the 100-level or higher
- :: You must have earned a "C" or better for a course to transfer
- If a course does not have an exact Illinois College equivalent, but is generally transferable, it can be accepted as an elective
- :: No more than 88 hours may be counted toward the Illinois College degree from two-year colleges

Financial Aid & Scholarships

- :: For financial aid, use the IC FAFSA code: 001688
- :: Transfer students are eligible for merit-based, renewable scholarships ranging from \$12,000 up to \$19,000 per year
- :: Transfer scholarships are awarded at the time of admission
- :: Visit our website for more information about scholarship opportunities for transfer students

The admission staff will review your application on the spot and provide you with an immediate admission decision on your transfer application to Illinois College. You can receive an estimated financial aid award before you leave campus if you have your FAFSA on file with Illinois College. You can also register for fall classes if you have submitted your \$200 enrollment deposit before or during your visit.
