






Lakeview's Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree will give graduates the opportunity to do the following:

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Early Decision

(Requires Min. 3.0/4.0 GPA)

- Fall Semester March 1
- Spring Semester ... August 1

Regular Decision

(Requires Min. 2.5/4.0 GPA)

- Fall Semester April 1
- Spring Semester ... September 1
