## INCOMING TRANSFER QUICK FACTS

### HOW?

Apply online through our [SXU Application](#) or the [Common App](#). The SXU Application has no fees. If you were invited to apply using our Priority Student Application, you can do so by following the links in the email and/or mailed invitations you received.

### WHEN?

Our application is open! We are currently accepting applications for spring, summer and fall 2023. SXU has no application fee. The recommendation is to apply as early as possible. We review applications on a rolling basis for non-nursing programs. As soon as all application materials are received, a typical admission decision will be made within two weeks of submission, unless communication with the student states otherwise.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A completed SXU application includes a submitted application and official college transcript(s) from any and all colleges/universities attended. Students with fewer than 30 credit hours are also required to submit their official final high school transcript. Applicants to our nursing program are required to submit additional materials that may include:

- an official TEAS exam score,
- a Nursing essay of interest,
- letters of recommendation, and
- a resume/CV

A personal statement for all other, non-nursing applicants is not required, but encouraged. Students may use the essay space to expand on their academic information or discuss any context that may be helpful to the application review committee.

## SCHOLARSHIPS

When students complete an SXU application, they are automatically reviewed for SXU's merit-based scholarships! If a transfer student is interested in participating in SXU's Honors program, they are encouraged to connect with their admission counselor. See our [Honors program page](#) for more information.

- Transfer Merit Scholarship:
  - \$10,000-\$18,000/year based on academic credentials
- Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) Scholarship:
  - \$19,000/year. Supersedes the Transfer Merit Scholarship
- Community colleges may provide additional scholarship opportunities (Chicago Star Scholarship, Crawley Scholarship, etc.). We encourage students to connect with their current institution and their SXU admission counselor to learn more.
- [SXU is partnered with several community colleges](#) including City Colleges of Chicago, Joliet Junior College, Moraine Valley Community College, Prairie State College, and South Suburban College. These partnerships offer exclusive scholarships, guaranteed admission to SXU, and on-campus access to SXU transfer resources including personalized advising and more.
  - To qualify for the transfer partnership agreement, students must be enrolled as a full-time student, have completed 12-45 credit hours, and be in good academic standing at one of our partner community colleges.

### **NURSING:**

The School of Nursing and Health Sciences at SXU is incredibly well ranked and one of our most popular programs. As such, it often reaches capacity. Students interested in Nursing are encouraged to apply as early as possible. An application and/or enrollment waitlist may be initiated depending on the number of applications received. The nursing application deadline is October 1 for the Spring semester, and April 1 for summer/fall semesters.
