## DePaul Updates

## • Scholarship Opportunities

All Transfer Students are now eligible to receive a merit scholarship, which range from \$3,000 to \$13,000 annually; in addition, students meeting the criteria will also receive a \$1,000 PTK scholarship, and/or \$2,000 Chicago STARS scholarship (excludes off-campus programs and students in the School of Continuing and Professional Studies).

#### • Vaccine Boosters

DePaul will require all students, faculty and staff to receive a COVID-19 booster as soon as they are eligible. The
booster requirement has the endorsement of Student Government Association, Faculty Council and Staff Council.
Students will have until their second quarter of enrollment to meet this requirement. More information can be

# • Jarvis College of Computing and Digital Media

Eugene P. Jarvis, a trailblazer in the video game industry, and his wife Sasha L. - Admission Requirements

   — DePaul University admits students each quarter to all university schools and colleges with
   the exception of the Theater School and the School of Music (fall admission only). Please contact those colleges
   separately for more information.
  - Traditional Transfer Students are under age 24 and have attended another college or university prior to applying to DePaul:
  - If students have completed 24 semester hours of transferable credit at another college or university when they apply, admission decision will be based on your college performance. Students with less than 24 hours will also be required to submit high school transcripts (ACT/SAT not required).
  - Adult Students (age 24 and above) can apply for admission to any traditional college or apply for admission to
    DePaul's School of Continuing and Professional Studies (SCPS). Adult students who have never enrolled in college
    or who have completed fewer than 12 transferable semester hours will be required to submit an official high school
    transcript or official GED score report for the traditional school.
  - **Admission Guidelines** All students applying to DePaul University for undergraduate admission are required to have the following GPAs:
    - College of Education: 2.5
    - School of Continuing and Professional Studies: 2.0 at last college attended

- School of Music: 2.75 and an audition required.
- The Theater School: 2.0, an audition or portfolio review, and interview required.
- Colleges of Liberal Arts & Social Sciences, Science and Health, Computing and Digital Media, Business,
   Communication: 2.0
