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FALL 2022 TRANSFER UPDATES

- A \$1,000/semester (renewable) grant is available for transfer students admitted to the Spring 2023 semester. To qualify, students must meet one-on-one with a Transfer Admission Counselor or attend an online or virtual event.
- Dominican University has recently been ranked in the 2023 Best Colleges report by US News and World Report as #1
 Most Innovative School in Illinois and #3 in the Midwest based on improvements identified in curriculum,
 technology, campus life, faculty, students or facilities. Additionally, Dominican won the #1 spots in Illinois for Best
 Value, top performer in social mobility in Illinois, and undergraduate teaching in Illinois.
- Dominican participates in the **Dream.US**, a program that offers scholarships to DACA eligible students. Ten (10) scholarships and a one-time \$1,000 stipend are awarded yearly to transfer students who are admitted for the Fall semester with 24+ semester hours of transfer credit and 3.3+ cumulative GPA. An application is required and deadlines apply.
- The School of Education sunset the Early Childhood Education major in Summer 2022, recommending students to pursue **Elementary Education** for teaching grades 1 through 6. Beginning in Fall 2022, the Elementary Education major has been updated to include an Early Childhood Education endorsement (birth through grade 2) making students more marketable in the field.
- Have students pursing an Associate in Applied Science (AAS)? If so, then consider one of Dominican's Bachelor of
 Applied Science (BAS) programs. The BAS is designed for students just finishing an AAS or adults already in the
 workforce and seeking to enhance their credentials. Two areas of study are offered:
 - ★ Bachelor of Applied Science in Health Sciences
 - ★ Bachelor of Applied Science in Informatics
 Specialties available in: Cybersecurity, Health Informatics, Organizational Informatics, Educational Informatics, or Community Informatics

Evening Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)

Through the Brennan School of Business, the Evening-BBA offers a mix of fully online, blended, and face-to-face classes that can be completed within 24 months. Cohorts begin each fall with the following majors:
