TRANSFERRING TO KNOX COLLEGE

If you have graduated from high school and completed at least a semester of coursework at a two-year or four-year college, you qualify as a transfer student.

TRANSFER CREDITS TO KNOX

- Our registrar will individually review your academic record so you receive the appropriate credit for your previous work. All transfer credits must have a grade of C or higher.
- Knox has established articulation agreements with two-year IAI colleges by which students graduating from those institutions with an Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree will be guaranteed a minimum of 18 3-3 calendar transfer credits (the equivalent of two years of college, or 60 semester credit hours) upon enrollment at Knox.

Small School BIG SCHOLARSHIPS

TRANSFER ACADEMIC MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

\$35,000–\$40,000 per year

Awards will be included with your letter of acceptance and are based on your application to Knox.

PHI THETA KAPPA SCHOLARSHIPS

\$5,000 per year

Awards based on membership in the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society and will be in addition to your academic merit scholarship.

ILLINOIS RESIDENT AWARD

\$5,000 per year for students who live in the state of Illinois

Awards will be included in your letter of acceptance based on the address on your application to Knox and will be in addition to your academic merit scholarship.

TALENT BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

Art, Dance, Music, Theatre, Writing

Up to \$8,000 per year

Awards are based on auditions, portfolios, and essays and will be in addition to your academic merit scholarship.
