- **Dr. Mia Hardy** joins Dominican from Oakton Community College as our new provost. Mia has held leadership roles at several Illinois community colleges, including City Colleges of Chicago. Mia is eager to increase our community college partnerships throughout this year.
- Dominican's **Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)** program accepts transfer students twice a year. Students must meet all university admission requirements and submit official ATI TEAS scores with a minimum of 68% by the deadline to be reviewed for admission into the BSN program by the Nursing Admissions and Progression Committee. In 2024, **97% of Dominican nursing graduates successfully passed the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX)**, outpacing state and national rates.
- Dominican's new **Bachelor of Business Analytics program** integrates business strategy with emerging technologies, empowering you to make confident, ethical, data-driven decisions.
- Our new **Financial Trading, Business Analytics, and Data Science Center** offers students hands-on experience with industry-standard tools like Bloomberg for market analysis, Tableau and Power BI for data visualization, and Python for machine learning.
