If you have graduated from high school and completed at least a semester of coursework at a two-year or four-year college, you qualify as a transfer student.

TRANSFER CREDITS TO KNOX

- Our registrar will individually review your academic record so you receive the appropriate credit for your previous work. All transfer credits must have a grade of C or higher.
- Knox has established articulation agreements with two-year IAI colleges by which students graduating from those institutions with an Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree will be guaranteed a minimum of 18 3-3 calendar transfer credits (the equivalent of two years of college, or 60 semester credit hours) upon enrollment at Knox.




